SCHOOL UNIFORM

Pupils are to be complimented for their neat and tidy appearance at school and we thank you for your co-operation regarding school uniform. Just a reminder to families of the following requirements regarding the school uniform:-

- Boys' Uniform: Blue shirt, navy tie, navy jumper and grey trousers.
- Girls' Uniform: Blue shirt, navy tie, navy jumper or navy cardigan and grey skirt, pinafore or trousers

In warm weather all children may wear short-sleeved blue shirts or blue short-sleeved collared t-shirts (e.g. polo shirts) and grey or navy shorts. Both the *main school uniform* and *designated school tracksuit* will be acceptable as daily school wear unless advised otherwise. In addition to school uniform requirements, we wish to draw the attention of Parents/Guardians to the following:

- Pupils may not wear jeans, leggings etc. to school.
- Girls may wear simple jewellery, e.g. small earning studs. The school reserves the right to designate the jewellery to be worn.
- For health and safety reasons, large hoop earrings, nose rings/studs, tongue, lip, eyebrow or other body pierced ornaments are not allowed for any pupil. No plasters or bandages disguising the ornament are allowed.
- For hygiene reasons, long hair should be tied back.
- We request that pupils do not come to school with their hair dyed.
- Pupils may not wear make-up to school.
