GET GOING...GET ROWING PROGRAMME (Sixth Class)

We are delighted to be one of the lucky schools selected by Rowing Ireland and Cork Sports Partnership to participate in the *Get Going...Get Rowing Programme* which is being run across a limited number of Cork primary schools during the 2018/19 school year. The aim of the programme is to introduce 6th class children to the sport of rowing in a supportive environment. The pupils will receive 3 structured coaching sessions by a Rowing Ireland certified community coach in the National Rowing Centre in Farran as well as water session.
